Marking Student Attendance from 1st of June 2020

You should continue to use the # code until your school reopens to eligible year groups. Once the school reopens to any of those year groups the following codes should be used as described.

/ - present - Should be used for pupils attending a session (standard use).

9 code for 'COVID - shielding' - Should be used for those who are shielding in relation to Covid-19. This includes those pupils who are shielding or pupils with EHCP plan and the school cannot safely meet their needs.

8 code for 'COVID - isolating' - Should be used for those who are self-isolating in relation to Covid-19.

7 code for 'Illness - COVID' - Should be used for a pupil who is absent due to <u>Covid-19</u> illness.

I code for non-covid illness - Should be used where a pupil cannot attend due to <u>non-Covid</u> <u>related illness</u>.

C code - Should be used where a pupil does not attend but is eligible and is not shielding or self isolating or ill. This should be used for students 5 and over as those under 5 an X code would be used.

X code - Should be used for pupils who are not eligible for a session - this includes children under school age (standard use) but also those not expected to be in for this particular session e.g. year 5 whose sessions are only Monday and Wednesday.

Other codes - Codes such as L and M should be used as normal and where appropriate.
